316 The following deed of Conveyance from John Clarke Kilpatrick to John M'Elroy Being proven before Robert Anderson of Pendleton County was presented & Recorded this 16th Aug^r 1793
This Indenture made this seventh day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety three
Between John Clarke Kilpatrick of Pendleton County of the one part, & John M'Elroy of Greenville County of the other part Witnesseth that the said John Clarke Kilpatrick for & in Consideration of the sum of Twelve pounds lawful Sterling Money to him in hand well and Truly paid at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents by the said John M'Elroy the Receipt thereof by the said John Clarke Kilpatrick hereby fully acknowledged, have Granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released and Confirmed, and by these presents doth Grant Bargain, sell, alien, release, & Confirm unto the said John M'Elroy his heirs & assigns for ever all that Tract of land situate lying and being in Greenville County on the Branch of Needy River Originally surveyed for the said John Clarke Kilpatrick, and Granted to him the said John Clarke Kilpatrick by his Excellency William Moultrie on the 5th of June 1786 containing six hundred & forty acres by the same more or less, as by a plat therunto annexed will fully appear being now in actual possession of him the said John M'Elroy, Together with all and singular Trees woods water & water Courses Hereditaments, rights, members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said parcel or Tract of land hereby bargained & sold belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the reversion & Reversions, Remainder and Remainders Rents Issues and profits thereof to have and to hold the said parcel or Tract of Land hereby bargained and sold with their & every of their appurtenances unto him the said John M'Elroy his heirs & assigns
