

348 This Indenture made this twentieth day of September
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
two and in the seventeenth year of the Independance of
America between Stephen Aide of the County of Greenville
and State of South Carolina of the one part and Abner Honey
of the County & State aforesaid of the other part the premises
that the said Stephen Aide for and in consideration of thirty
pounds Sterling Money of South Carolina to him in hand
well and truly paid by the said Abner Honey at and before the
sealing and delivery of these presents the Receipt whereof the
said Stephen Aide doth hereby acknowledge and thereof of
and from every part & parcel thereof do acquit and discharge
the said Abner Honey his heirs and assigns and for divers
other good causes and considerations hereunto moving have
granted bargained sold aliened Enfeoffed and confirmed unto
the said Abner Honey his heirs and assigns for ever one hun-
dred acres of land more or less lying or being in Greenville
County on the waters of Needy River being part of a tract of
land Originally Granted to John Cofferty and Signed by his
Excellency Thomas Pinckney on the sixth day of October one
thousand seven hundred and Eighty Eight as by a plat
annexed to the said Grant will more fully appear being laid
out unto the said Abner Honey as follows Beginning on a Stake
which stands in the line of the said land, and from thence
running on a conditional line through the said land to a
Stake from thence Running N^o 58 E to a post oak corner from
thence Running N^o 35 E 13-25 to a post oak corner from thence
Running in to a corner ^{on} to a post oak, from thence Running N^o
10 E 7-5 to a corner on a black oak, from thence Running
N^o 22 E 15-50 to a corner on a stake from thence Running
N^o 40 E 31-25 to a light wood stake from thence Running
N^o 15 W to the beginning containing one hundred acres of land

out houses ways waters paths trees fences easements heredi-
taments and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of
