

950 The following deed of Conveyance from Archibald
Fowler and Ede Fowler to George Underwood being proven
before Robert M'aser Esq. by the oath of Lewis Ruter
was presented and Recorded this 20th November 1799

This Indenture made this seventh day of October
one thousand seven hundred and ninety three Between
Archibald Fowler & Ede Fowler his wife of the County
of Greenville State of South Carolina of the one
part and George Underwood of said County State
of the other part; whereas by a certain Grant bearing
date the fourth day of February one thousand seven
hundred & ninety three from under the hand of his
Excellency William Moultrie Esquire Governor and
Commander in Chief in and over the said State
having the great seal of the state thereunto affixed
being for that purpose appointed did give and Grant
unto Archibald Fowler a plantation or Tract of Land
Containing Eight hundred & forty acres situated &
lying in Greenville County ninety six district A side
of Reedy River on Laurel Creek and branches of Richland
Creek and hath such forms & Marks bullings and
boundings as appears by a plat thereunto annexed which
said plat and Grant being duly Recorded in the Sur-
tary's Office Grant Book G N 5 Page 9 Reference
being thereunto had may more fully & at large appear
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Archibald
Fowler Ede Fowler his wife for and in Consideration of
the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling Money of this
State to them in hand paid by the above mentioned
George Underwood the Receipt whereof is hereby ac-
knowledged hath Granted bargained & sold by these
present's with grant bargain sell and Convey unto
George Underwood one hundred & forty acres out of
the above described grant of Eight hundred & forty
and hath such forms and Marks as are hereinafter
