

954 The following Deed of Conveyance from Edmund Bearden & Ann Bearden to William M'Clanahan was presented and acknowledged in open Court and Ordered to be Recorded which was done this 23rd day of November 1793

This Indenture made this seventh day of October in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety three and eighteenth year of American Independency Between Edmund Bearden and Ann Bearden his wife of the one part being of Greenville County State of South Carolina and William M'Clanahan of Culpeper County State of Virginia of the other part Whereas by a certain Grant bearing date the fourth day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety three from under the hand of his Excellency William Moultrie Esquire Governor and commander in Chief in and over the said State having the great seal of State thereunto affixed being for that purpose appointed did give and Grant unto Edmund Bearden a plantation or tract of Land containing four hundred and fifty two acres situated and lying in Greenville County and on the branches of Reddy River and has such forms and Marks buttings and Boundings as appear by a plat thereunto annexed which said Plat and Grant being duly Recorded in the Secretarys Office Grant Book E. C. V. 3 page 117 Reference being thereunto had may more fully and at large appear Now This Indenture witnesseth that the said Edmund Bearden & Ann Bearden his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling Money of this State to them in hand paid by the said William M'Clanahan before the sealing and delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted bargained & sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell & Convey unto the said William M'Clanahan two hundred & thirty acres out of the above described Grant of four hundred & fifty two acres and hath such Marks and forms as are
