

270 The following Deed of Conveyance from Adam Cantwell
to Abraham Bradley being proven before Samuel Earle Esq^r
by the oath of William Thurston was produced and recorded
this 4th day of December 1792

This Indenture made this twenty seventh day of April
one thousand seven ninety three between Adam Cantwell
of Greenville County & State of South Carolina of the one part
and Abraham Bradley of the County & State aforesaid of the
other part Witnesseth for in consideration of forty pounds
Sterling & more in hand paid to the S^r Adam Cantwell
by the said Abraham Bradley before the signing & delivery
hereof the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the aforesaid
Adam Cantwell hath hereby bargained sold & conveyed to the
before mentioned Abraham Bradley a certain tract or parcel
of land containing one hundred acres by the same more or
less situate in Greenville County on the head of Austers
Creek branch of Saluda River & bounding Southwardly on
Lands belonging to Valentine Thacker and Westwardly on
Lands belonging to Abraham Bradley and Northwardly on
Lands belonging to John Mayton together with all & singular
the woods & waters profits commodities hereditaments and
appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any
wise appurtenant to have & hold the S^r Adam Cantwell
of land containing one hundred acres more or less hereby
granted and sold with their & every of their appurtenances
unto the said Abraham Bradley his heirs & assigns forever
and the said Adam Cantwell for himself his heirs & assigns
Adm^r & assigns the said hereby bargained premises with
their appurtenances unto the said Abraham Bradley his heirs
and assigns against the claim or claims of every person
or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant & defend
by these presents In witness whereof the said Adam
Cantwell hath hereunto set his hand & seal the day
and date first above written
