374 The following Deed of Conveyance from Samuel McKinney to Alexander McKinney being sworn before Reuben Barnett Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Leonard Clayborne was presented and Recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> Day of Dec<sup>r</sup> 1779. 3  
This Instrument made this third day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety three and in the sixteenth year of American Independence between Samuel McKinney of the one part & Alex<sup>r</sup> McKinney of the other both of the State of South Carolina & County of Greenville Witnesseth that the said Samuel McKinney for & consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling paid to him in hand paid by the s<sup>d</sup> Alex<sup>r</sup> McKinney at or before the sealing of these presents the Receipt & payment whereof is fully acknowledged, both given Granted and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and alien and Release convey and confirm unto the said Alex<sup>r</sup> McKinney and to his heirs and assigns forever a certain piece tract or parcel of land situate lying & being in the County & State aforesaid on the s<sup>d</sup> Saluda River being part of a tract of land granted unto the said Jonathan Musick by letters patent bearing date the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred and Eighty six and tenth year of American Independence bearing & bounding as follows Viz, Beginning at a stake corner on the S<sup>th</sup> line 27 Chain from the lower end of the tract & Running N<sup>o</sup> 52<sup>o</sup> W 27 chain at a Pin Corner thence N<sup>o</sup> 48<sup>o</sup> W 11 Chains to a stake thence N<sup>o</sup> 35<sup>o</sup> E 19 Chain to the beginning; containing by Estimation 34
