382 The following Decree of Conveyance from William Savage to
Nancy Gilbreath was produced & acknowledged in open Court
by J. Savage & Ordered to be Recorded which was done 19th Dec 1793
State of South Carolina This Indenture made this
thirty first day of August in the year of our Lord one thou-
sand seven hundred and Ninety three and in the seventh year of
the Sovereignty and Independence of the united States of America
between William Savage of the State of South Carolina & County
of Greenville planter of the one part & Nancy Gilbreath of
the said State & County of the other part Witnesseth that
the said William Savage for & in consideration of the full &
Just sum of ten pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the
said Nancy Gilbreath the Receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledge have granted bargain sold & by these presents doth
give grant bargain sell and Deliver unto the said Nancy
Gilbreath her heirs & Assigns for ever in fee simple
one hundred acres of Land in Now or less being the upper part
of a tract of Land granted to William Savage containing six
hundred & Eighteen acres surveyed for him the thirteenth day
of October one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Eight
situate in the District of Ninety six in Greenville County
on a Branch of Ennore River and branches of the Ennore River
dam creek of South Tygar River bounded by lines running
North West by Richlands land North East & South East by
Vacant Land South West & South East by John Hettors land
West by Kelleys land South East & South West by William
Savage land North East Kelleys land & Recorded in Secretarys
Office in Grant Book C. N. 5 page 152 Reference hereunto
being always had to have and to hold the above one hundred
acres of Land with their appurtenances & Heredatements
hereunto belonging unto her the said Nancy Gilbreath
her heirs & Assigns for ever free and clear from all Incumbrances
and from and against the Claim or claims of any person or
persons whatsoever & the the J. William Savage doth for himself
