George Graham being proven before Reuben Parrott Esq.  
by the Oath of Sonias Dawson was Recorded 20<sup>th</sup> Dec 1773  
This Indenture made this 5<sup>th</sup> Day of October in the year  
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three  
Between Bright Pruitt of the County of Greenville State  
of South Carolina of the one part & George Graham of Gran-  
ville County State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth  
that the said Bright Pruitt for & in consideration of the  
sum of Two hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid  
by George Graham, the Receipt whereof the said Bright  
Pruitt doth hereby acknowledge and himself therewith  
fully satisfied & paid hath granted bargained sold convey-  
ed & confirmed and by these presents doth fully freely clearly  
and absolutely grant bargain & convey & confirm unto  
the said George Graham his heirs & assigns forever  
a tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and  
fifty one acres lying within the County of Greenville  
aforesaid on both sides of Morgan's Creek begining at  
a post N 48 E 80 acres oak N 25 W 33-00 Robert Goodson.  
Thomas Dawson to Chest. oak 8 ft p Chest & corner N 62 W 80  
40 ft aced oak 0.9 ft W 35-00 to a Spanish Oak sapling  
at the head of the middle branch, thence taking the mean-  
der of S. branch Cross said Morgan's Creek to the S line  
to a white oak thence East to aced oak thence 135 ft 30  
to Absalom Thompson's line to a stake thence E 23-50  
to aced oak thence N 19 to first station on a post it
