Huse Cantwell being proven before In<sup>o</sup> Thomas Esq<sup>r</sup> by the Oath  
of Tho<sup>s</sup> Norris was recorded this 27<sup>th</sup> May 1794

This Indenture made this Twenty seventh day of January  
1794 Between In<sup>o</sup> Cantwell Sen<sup>r</sup> Greenville County South  
Carolina of the one part & Huse Cantwell son of In<sup>o</sup> Cantwell  
Sen<sup>r</sup> of the above County & State of the other part witnesseth  
that for the consideration of the sum of Twenty five pounds  
to him in hand paid the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged  
the s<sup>d</sup> In<sup>o</sup> Cantwell Sen<sup>r</sup> hath granted bargained sold & conveyed  
and by these presents do hereby grant bargain sell and convey to  
the said Huse Cantwell his heirs & assigns a certain Tract of  
land beginning where James Hoody's line crosses the path on  
the south line running from thence to the Spring, running down  
that branch to big branch which is to continue the line to  
the dividing line between Richard Hooper & the said John Cant-  
well which line is the dividing on the west side of the branch  
between Richard Hooper & Huse Cantwell to west line between  
Thomas Hooper and the said Cantwell containing one  
hundred acres more or less to have and to hold the aforesaid  
land with all the appurtenances there belonging by him the  
said Huse Cantwell his heirs & assigns for ever and the said  
John Cantwell for himself his heirs or assigns or any of them  
will hereby warrant and for ever defend the aforesaid land  
from Surt Claim of himself his heirs and all other demands  
whatsoever to the said Huse Cantwell his heirs and assigns
