This Indenture made this tenth day of February one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and in the seventeenth year of American Independance between Charles Sullivant of the state of South Carolina Ninety six district of the one part, & Moses Sullivant of the said State & District of the other part witnesseth that the said Charles Sullivant for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money by the said Moses Sullivant at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof he the said Charles Sullivant doth hereby acknowledge, and from every part and parcel thereof, do acquit and discharge the said Moses Sullivant him and his heirs and assigns and for divers other good Causes and considerations hereunto moving have Granted bargained sold aliened conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do Grant bargain
