Benj^m Bruce being proven before Robert Mafec Esq^r by the
oath of Martin Dye was Recorded this 6th day of June 1744
This Indenture made this seventh day of December in
the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three
between Gibson Southern Southern of the State of South Carolina
Greenwich County of the one part and Benjamin Bruce of the
State and County aforesaid witnesseth that the said Gibson Southern
for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling
Money to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Ben-
jamin Bruce at or before the sealing and delivery of these pre-
sents the receipt whereof the said Gibson Southern doth hereby
acknowledge he the said Gibson Southern hath granted bargained
and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth
Grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Benjamin
Bruce his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract of land
computed to contain three hundred acres part of a tract Grant-
ed to Nath^l Conner by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r
then conveyed from Conner to Isaac Morgan, and from Morgan
to Southern Situate in Washington District on the North side
of Enoree River Beginning at a pine on the N^e side of a branch
called the long branch of the upper line of said Tract then running
ad^e course with a marked line to a Black Oak then to a stake
a corner of Bidwells land then with Bidwells line S. 35 W
to Sanders line thence with Sanders line to a chestnut on the
upper line of said Tract thence with the old line to the beginning
