Monroe was Recorded this 7th day of June A.D. 1794

This Indenture made this twenty fourth day of April in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between
Obadiah Hooper of Franklin County State of Georgia of the one
part, Young Griffin of the County of Greenville of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Obadiah Hooper for and in consideration
of the sum of forty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Young
Griffin the receipt hereof is hereby acknowledged, granted bargain-
ed and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain & sell unto
The said Young Griffin his heirs and assigns for ever a certain
Tract or parcel of land containing two hundred and fifty acres be-
the same more or less lying and being in the County of Greenville
State of South Carolina on the waters of Enore River bounding
as followeth Viz, beginning pine adjoining a Tract of land laid out
