 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety three
 Between Richard Forrester of Greenville County & State of South
 Carolina of the one part & Philip Sherrel of the State and County of
 said of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard Forrester for
 and in consideration of the sum of twenty four pounds Sterling
 Money to him the said Richard Forrester in hand well & Truly paid
 by the said Philip Sherrel at and before the sealing and delivery of
 these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he the said
 Richard Forrester hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed
 conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant bargain
 sell, alien, enfeoff convey and confirm unto the said Philip Sher-
 rel his heirs and assigns for ever in his actual possession now
 being, all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred &
 237 Twenty eight acres Situate lying and being in the County of four.
