48^o The following Deed of Conveyance from Joseph Reed to
 William Nicholson being proven before John Alexander Esq.
 by the Oath of Wm. Reed was Recorded this 23rd June 1794
 State of South Carolina. This Indenture made the fif-
 teenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety three between Joseph Reed of the
 County of Greenville & State aforesaid of the one part &
 William Nicholson of the County & State aforesaid of the
 other part Witnesseth that the said Joseph Reed for his con-
 sideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling
 Money to him in hand paid by the s^d William Nicholson
 at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents
 the receipt of which the said Joseph Reed doth acknowledge
 and thereof and from every part and parcel thereof doth
 acquit and discharge the said William Nicholson his heirs
 and assigns, and for divers other good causes & considerations
 hereunto moving have granted bargained sold aliened
 enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said William
 Nicholson his heirs and assigns for ever all that plantation
 or tract of land containing two hundred acres originally
 granted unto John Pitts and signed by his Excellency Tho-
 mas Pinckney on the first day of december one thousand
 seven hundred and eighty eight situate in Greenville
 on a branch of Rocky Creek waters of Reedy River Beginning
 at a light wood stake 3+ and runs N 67^o 50 to a Spanish
 oak 3+ from thence N 42^o 54 to a Black oak 3+ thence S 42^o 56
