

The following Deed of Conveyance from Benj^m Dollard to
John Linderman being proven before Larkin Carnant Esq^r
by the oath of John Chambers is Recorded this 31st October 1794
This Indenture made this seventh day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety two Be-
tween Benjamin Dollard of Greenville County, & State of South
Carolina of the one part & John Linderman of the County
& State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Ben-
jamin Dollard for & in consideration of the sum of seventy
pounds Sterling Money to him in hand well & truly paid
by the said John Linderman at & before the sealing & delivering
of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Benjamin
Dollard doth hereby acknowledge, & thereof & from every part
and parcel thereof do acquit & discharge the said John Lin-
derman his heirs & assigns, & for divers other good causes &
considerations hereunto moving, have granted bargained
sold aliened enfeoffed & confirmed unto the said John Linder-
man his heirs & assigns for ever two hundred & fifty acres of
land more or less being part of a Tract of land Originally
Granted to James McWilliams & Signed by his Excellency
Thomas Pinckney on the fifth day of January one thou-
sard seven hundred & eighty nine, containing two hun-
dred & seventy six acres situate in the County of Greenville
on the South side of Reedy River, the above mentioned two
hundred & fifty acres of land being laid out unto the said
John Linderman as follows, Beginning on a Sassafras tree
which stands on the Bank of S^d Reedy River, from thence running
S 25 W 49-50 to the Corner on a post oak, thence running N 50 W 20-
00 to the Corner on a post oak, from thence running N 10 E 17-60 a
Corner on a stake thence running N 75 E 10 to the Corner on a pine
from thence running N 15 E 95 to a water oak on the Bank of said
Reedy River, from thence bounded on the S^d River down to the begin-
