man being proven before Parkin Tarrant Esq^r by the oath of Jacob
Black was presented & recorded this 31st day of October 1794

This Indenture made the eighth day of January one thousand
seven hundred and ninety three Between John Dyle Junior of the
State of S. Carolina and County of Greenville of the one part, and
Henry Linderman Sen^r. of the State & County aforesaid of the
other part, witnesseth that the said John Dyle Jun^r. for the consider-
ation of the sum of seventeen pounds current Money of the
State aforesaid to him in hand paid by the said Henry Linder-
man at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said John Dyle
Jun^r. hath Granted bargained & sold, & by these presents do
grant bargain & sell & confirm unto the said Henry Linder-
man Sen^r. his heirs and assigns for ever, all that plantation or
tract of land situate in Ninety six old district and County of
Greenville, on a small branch of Reedy River known by the name
of the Spring branch containing three hundred acres more
or less, being Originally Granted to John Dyle Sen^r. by his Ex-
cellency William Moultrie Governor on the eighth day of June
A^D 1785 & conveyed to his son John Dyle Jun^r. on the twenty
third day of October A^D 1788 Reference being had to the Surveyor's
Office for the original Grant, & to the Clerks Office of
the County aforesaid for the conveyance will more fully &
larger appear, together with all woods ways, water & water courses
profits & appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in
any wise appertaining to the said tract of three hundred acres
of land more or less situate as aforesaid, and the reversion &
Reversions Remainders and Remainders, rents & benefits of the
said ²⁶³ premises and every part thereof, & all the estate right title
Interest or demand either in law or equity to the premises
above mentioned to have & to hold the above premises with all
