This Indenture made the 28 of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred Ninety four Between John Hunt of the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina of the one part, & William Leach of the County & State aforesaid Witnesseth that the said John Hunt for and in consideration of the sum of ten Shillings to him in hand paid by the S^r William Leach the receipt whereof the said John Hunt doth acknowledge he the the said John Hunt hath granted bargained and sold & confirmed and by these presents unto the said William Leach his heirs and assigns for ever a certain tract or parcel of land containing eight hundred and fifty acres be the same more or less situate in the County aforesaid on the main Branch of Brush Creek of Reedy River beginning on a Black Oak N 45 E to a post oak on Allstons line then S 62 E to a post oak on Barnhells corner, then S 16 W to a white oak on Thompsons line then S 70 W to Townsers line, then N 15 E to a Branch, then ²⁷¹ down the said Branch to Brush Creek, then down the Creek to the mouth of a Branch on the other side of ²⁷¹ Creeks
