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The following Deed of Conveyance from John Hunt to William Peach being proven before Robert McCaig Esq: by the Oath of Wm Towns was presented and Recorded this 31st Day of April 1794
This Indenture made the 48 of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & thirty four
Between John Hunt of the County of Greenville &
State of South Carolina of the one part, & William
Peach of the County & State aforesaid witnesseth that
the said John Hunt for and in consideration of the sum
of ten Shillings to him in hand paid by the said William
Peach the receipt whereof the said John Hunt doth acknowledge he the said John Hunt hath granted bargained
and sold & confirmed and by these presents unto the
said William Peach his heirs and assigns for ever a
certain tract or parcel of land containing eight hundred
and fifty acres be the same more or less situate in the
County aforesaid on the main Branch of Brush Creek
of Reedy River begining on a Black Jack N 45 E to a
post oak on Alstons line then S 62 E to a post oak on Barn
hells corner, then S 16 W to a white oak on Thompsons line
then S 70 W to Townses line, then N 15 E to a Branch then
down the said Branch to Brush Creek, then down the s^d
Creek to the mouth of a Branch on the other side of s^d Creek
