2 The following Deed of Conveyance from Edmund Bearden to Joseph
Willis being proven before Robert M^oase Esq^r by the oath of
Thomas Edwards was presented and Recorded 8th January 1795
This Indenture made this sixteenth day of August in the year
of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four & in
the nineteenth year of the Independency of America Between
Edmund Bearden of the County of Greenville & State of South Caro-
lina of the one part & Joseph Willis of said County & State of the
Other part whereas by a certain grant bearing date the fourth
day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand seven
hundred and ninety three from under the hand of his Excellency
William Moultrie Esq^r Governor and commander in chief
in and over the said state having the great seal of the State
therunto affixed being for that purpose appointed dea give &
grant unto Edmund Bearden a plantation or tract of land con-
taining four hundred & fifty two situated and lying in the County
aforesaid & District of Washington and on the banks of Beedy River
and has such founs and marks buttings & boundings as appears
by a plat therunto annexed which said plat & Grant being duly
Recorded in the Secretarys Office Grant Book B. N^o 5 page
447 reference being therunto had may more fully appear
Now this Indenture Witnesseth that the said Edmund Bearden
for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds
Sterling Money of this State to him in hand paid by the said
Joseph Willis before the sealing and delivering of these presents
