This Indenter made this twenty fourth of June in the year of our Lord
one thousand seven hundred & ninety four William Queen of Rede-
ford County & State of North Carolina of the one part, & Samuel
Queen of the County Buncombe & State of North Carolina of the other
part witnesseth that the said William Queen for and in consideration
of the sum fifty pounds Sterling Money well and truly paid by the s^d.
Samuel Queen at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents
the receipt thereof the said William Queen doth hereby acknowledge and
thereof & of & firmly every part and parcel thereof do acquit & discharge
the said Queen and his heirs & assigns and for divers other good causes
and consideration hereunto moving have granted & bargained &
sold & have enaffirmed confirm unto the s^d. Samuel Queen and assigns
for ever all that parcel or tract of land lying & being in Greenville
County in the State of South Carolina on a branch of reedy River
on the south side of said River containing one hundred & ninety
three Acres it being part of a larger Tract of one thousand acres
Originally granted to the said John Safferty & beginning at a Dead
oak from thence to Jacob Blackline for compliment & Relinquely
granted to the said John Safferty & signed by his Ecclesy Thomas
Pinckney the twenty fourth day of September one thousand seven
hundred & eighty eight by a plat annexed the s^d. Grant will more
fully appear together with all and singular the hereditaments &
appurtenances at whatsoever to the s^d. Tract of land so describer
