 Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four between Joseph
 French of Guenville County & State of South Carolina of the one
 part, & George Salmon of the State & County aforesaid of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said Joseph French for & in consideration
 of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to him the said Jos-
 eph French in hand well & truly paid by the said George Salmon
