The following deed of Conveyance from Randolph Casey to Mark
 Forrester being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq^r by the oath of said
 Casey was presented and Recorded this 28th April 1795
 This Indenture made the twenty fifth day of August in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between Ran-
 dolph Casey of Franklin County Georgia State of the one part and
 Mark Forrester of Greenville County S^c Carolina of the other part
 Witnesseth that the said Randolph Casey for and in consideration
 of the sum of twenty pounds current Money of S^c Carolina to
 him the said Casey in hand well and Truly paid by the s^d Forrester
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the s^d Casey hath
 granted bargained sold aliened released conveyed & confirmed by
 these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey and
 confirm unto the said Mark Forrester his heirs and assigns for ever
 a tract of land containing one hundred and thirty six acres
 surveyed for him the fourteenth day of May 1787 Situate in
 the District of Washington on both sides of the South fork of
 Tugger River, bounded S.E. by the s^d Randolph Casey N. by James
 Forrester land all other sides by Vacant Land with all the houses
 buildings Orchards trees woods under woods & the commons com-
 mons of pasture profits commodities advantages hereditaments wa-
 ters water courses and appurtenances whatsoever to the same
