74 The following deed of Conveyance from Hugh Warren to John Malin
being proven before Reuben Barnett Esq. by the oath of Joseph Colla-
way was presented and Recorded this 29th day of April 1795
This Indenture made this thirteenth day of September in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and in the
Nineteenth year of American Independance between Hugh Warren Sen^r
of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part
and John Malin of the State and County aforesaid of the other part
Witnesseth that whereas in and by a certain Grant bearing date the
Twenty first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and eighty five under the hand of his Excellency Ben-
jamin Guillard Esq. Governor and commander in Chief in and over the
said State having the great Seal of the State thereunto affixed did give
and grant unto John Collins certain tract of land containing by estima-
tion two hundred and five acres situated lying and being in Greenville
County & State aforesaid and on both sides of South Tyger River &
having such forms marks buttings and boundings as are represented
by a plat to the said Grant annexed which plat and grant being duly
recorded in the Secretarys Office of said State reference had will more
fully appear and by the said John Collins sold and conveyed by a
deed of Conveyance to the aforesaid Hugh Warren Sen^r the eighth
