

The following Deed of Conveyance from Robert Talkington to Jeremiah Tubb being proven before Robert Mather Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of H<sup>on</sup> Tubb was presented and Recorded this 30<sup>th</sup> day of April 1795

State of South Carolina; This Indenture made this second day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety four between Robert Talkington of the aforesaid State and County of Greenville of the one part, and Jeremiah Tubb of the aforesaid State and county of the other part Witnesseth that said Robert Talkington for an In consideration of the sum of Twenty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Jeremiah Tubb unto the said Robert Talkington hath granted bargained & sold by these his heirs Ex<sup>ors</sup> and assigns a certain tract of land containing two hundred and fifty acres more or less it being apart of a tract of four thousand acres granted to Robert Prince the seventeenth day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven bounded as follows beginning at a post oak on Derrys corner thence with said line to a stake on Turnboughs line thence with said line to a spanish oak, thence with said line to a red oak thence with S. line to a pine on Savages Corner thence with S. line to a post oak from thence to a stake, and from thence to the beginning Situate in the district of Washington on Enoree River west of the Indian boundary line Together with all woods Trees water water courses profits commodities appurtenances and hereditaments whatsoever thereunto belonging to have and to hold the said tract of land a quantity aforesaid and all and singular of
