



I to hoto all & Singular the aforesaid land & premises unto the S^d Joseph Hawks his heirs & assigns for Every in fee simple & that he is at the time of conveying the aforesaid Land possessor of good & lawfull right & title there to in fee simple & the S^d Robert Taylor & Ann his wife by their warrant & for Every defend the right of the aforesaid land to the S^d Joseph Hawks his heirs & assigns for Every in fee simple against the Claim or claims of all & Every other person or persons that may at any time hereafter set up any title or claim to the same or any part thereof. in witness whereof the S^d Robert Taylor & Ann his wife hath hereunto set their hands & seals the day & date first above written signed & sealed & acknowledged in the presence of Samuel Duncan

The following Instrument of writing from John B. Grigsby & Elisabeth his wife to Elias Earle & John Robinson being proven before William Anderson Esquire by the oath of Joseph Williams was presented & Recorded this 29th day of January 1796—

This deed of Gift bearing date this ninth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety six, doth bear witness that John Grigsby & Elisabeth his wife do of their own free voluntary will & Consent & for the Consideration of the sum of five hundred Sterling money to them in hand paid hath given granted bargained & sold unto John Robinson & Elias Earle a certain number of negro Slaves. Now in the possession of the S^d John B. Grigsby & Elisabeth his wife on these express Considerations as herein after set fourth which negroes are by name as followeth Viz. Rob, Ann, Frank, Stephen, ^{Flora} ~~Flora~~ Mimma Nancy, Jacob, Nimro, Jack, Chandler, Sally, Aggy, Mary & Boyle; of the value of one thousand pounds Sterling money & that ^{Flora} ~~Flora~~ increase of the S^d female negroes, the S^d negroes are on the signing & acknowledging this their deed, in & are delivered up & put in the peaceable & quiet possession & without interruption or molestation are from this time in possession of the S^d John Robinson & Elias Earle & to have & to hoto the aforesaid negroes for the uses & purposes as follows that on the request & desire of the S^d John B. Grigsby & Elisabeth his wife all the aforesaid negroes at their decease shall be equally divided by the S^d John Robinson & Elias Earle into two equal parts & the one part given to the children of the S^d John Robinson
