232 The following Deed of Conveyance from Austin Clayton to Roland Sutton being proven before James Garrison Esq^t by the oath of Jeremiah Salmon was presented and Recorded this 19th day of April A.D. 1796
This Indenture made this nineteenth day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between Austin Clayton of the one part & Roland Sutton of the other both of the State of South Carolina & Spartanburg & Greenville Counties witnesseth that for & in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds to him in hand paid by the said Roland Sutton at or before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt & payment whereof is hereby acknowledged he hath bargained Granted and sold and by these presents doth give grant bargain & sell a Tract or parcel of land containing two hundred acres by the same more or less situated in Greenville County on the waters of Fortانبuries River it being part of a Tract of Land which his Excellency William Moultrie did give & grant unto Austin Clayton bearing date the fifth day of July one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and Recorded in Grant Book G N^o. 5 page 346 which tract of Land contained 572 acres the aforesaid tract or parcel of Land containing two hundred begining on a Spanish Oak runs thence N^o. 45 1/4 16 ch 50 links to a red oak thence N 10 ch to a pine, thence N. 33 W. 53 ch to a Stake on Barnes branch, thence as Barnes branch Maind to Verner's line, thence with Verner's line to a maple in a branch on Drees line, thence to the begining said Spanish oak together with all singular the premises & appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining with all & every the estate rights, Interests, claims & demands rents issues and profits clear of all incumbrances, Judgments Mortgages escripts evidences or writings whatsoever unto the said Roland Sutton his heirs Esq^t Adm^t or assigns to be only prop or use and behoof of him the said Roland Sutton his heirs and assigns for ever the the s^r Austin Clayton his heirs Esq^t and Adm^t shall have
