 wife to Larkin Tarrant being proven before J. Amb. Blackburn Esq^r

This Indenture made the Twenty fourth day of September one thousand
 seven hundred and ninety four between John Pyle of Greenville County
 State of S. Carolina of the one part & Larkin Tarrant Esq^r of the other
 part witnesseth that the said John Pyle & Sarah his wife for & in consid-
 ration of the sum of two hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid at
 & before the sealing & delivery of these presents by the S. Larkin Tarrant
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the S. John Pyle & Sarah his
 wife doth & hath hereby granted bargain'd & sold & by these presents grant
 bargain & sell unto the S. Larkin Tarrant Esq^r his heirs & assigns for ever
 all that plantation whereon the S. John Pyle now lives, containing three
 hundred acres be the same more or less situate on the west side of Mill
 branch of the golden grove being part of that tract Originally granted to
 William Wood on the sixteenth day of July 1788 & recorded in grant Book
 A. A. A. page (56) reference being had thereunto with more full particu-
 lars
