

286 The following deed of Conveyance from William Dine to George French being proven before John Alexander Esq^r by the oath of Henry Henry Wagner was presented and Recorded this 11th day of August 1798 South Carolina This Indenture made this fifth day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety two between William Dine of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part & George French of the said state & County of the other part witnesseth that the said William Dine for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds lawful sterling Current money to him in hand well and truly paid at & before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said George French the receipt thereof is hereby fully acknowledged has granted bargained sold aliened released and confirmed and by these presents doth bargain sell alien release and confirm unto him the said George French him his heirs and assigns for ever all that part of a certain Tract of land lying in Greenville County on the waters of Saluda River Originally granted unto Miles Sinninge for 1828 acres and signed by his Excellency William Moultrie on the 5th April 1786 as by a plat therunto annexed will appear all that part of the said Tract beginning in the fork of a Road ... a small post oak Corner from thence NW 20^o 8 chains from thence North 10 chains from thence NW 20^o 8 chains from thence NW 15^o 15 chains thence NW 19^o 10 chains thence NW 15^o 12 chains to a red oak corner meandering with the road from the red oak corner NW 60^o 13 chains to red oak corner from thence NW 38^o 32 chains fifty links to a pine corner from thence SW 75^o 51 chains to a stake on the Original line from thence S.E. 10^o on the old line 12 chains to a white oak corner near a branch thence SW 90^o 10 chains to a pine the old corner from thence S.E. 50^o on the old line 36 chains to a red oak near branch from thence N.E. 75^o nine chains, N.E. 80^o ten chains N.E. 85^o eighteen chain fifty links to a large red oak on the Road from thence SW 4^o nineteen chains to State Corner, thence S.E. 75^o 10 chains fifty links to State corner, thence N.E. 59^o 20 chains to State from thence East to the beginning containing five hundred and thirty six acres to the same mode or top Together with all and singular the trees waters hereditaments rights members and appurtenances whatsoever to the said Tract of land belonging or in any wise appertaining and the reversion and reversions rents issues and profits thereof To have and to hold the said parcel or Tract of land and premises hereby bargained and sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said George French him his heirs & assigns to his and their only proper use and behoof absolutely forever & lastly the said William Dine doth for himself theirs the said Tract of land as above described unto the said George French him his heirs or assigns against all and every person or persons whatsoever that shall wear out and for ever defend as witness thereto the said William Dine doth hereunto set his hand and seal this day and year first above written this 5th April 1798
