 I William Townes of Greenville County & State of S. Carolina in con-  
 sideration of one hundred pounds Sterling Money of the State aforesaid  
 said to me paid by Samuel Townes of the County & State aforesaid have  
 granted bargained sold & released and by these presents do grant  
 bargain, sell and release unto the S. Samuel Townes all that plantation  
 or tract of land containing one hundred and sixty acres more or less  
 situated lying and being in the County & State aforesaid on a small  
 branch of Saluda River, Beginning on a white oak St in the fork of a  
 Branch, thence N. 30 E. 10 ch<sup>s</sup> to a large white oak St, thence N. 39  
 E. 29 ch<sup>s</sup> to a Turkey oak St, thence N. 30 E. 31 ch<sup>s</sup> to a pine St, thence  
 S. 29 E. 12 ch<sup>s</sup> to a post oak St, thence S. 7 E. 15 ch<sup>s</sup> to a post oak St thence  
 S. 15 E. 29 ch<sup>s</sup> 50 ch<sup>s</sup> to a poplar St a Branch St, thence N. 66 W. 17 ch<sup>s</sup> 50  
 ch<sup>s</sup> to a post oak St at the head of a Branch thence down the meanders of  
 S. Branch to the beginning bounded on lines running N. E. & N. W. by William  
 Townes land & Sam. Clayton's land N. E. & S. E. by John Blasingame & Lem<sup>l</sup>  
 J. Alston's land, Together with all and singular the rights members here-  
 ditaments, and appurtenances to the S. premises belonging or in any wise  
 Incident or appurtenant to have and to hold all and singular the  
 premises above mentioned unto the S. Sam<sup>l</sup> Townes his heirs & assigns  
 forever, I do hereby bind myself my heirs Exors. & Adm<sup>rs</sup>. to war-  
 rant and defend unto all and singular the S. premises unto the  
 S. Sam<sup>l</sup> Townes his heirs and assigns against myself & my heirs and  
 assigns whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same
