The following deed of conveyance from Isaac Wilkins to Edward Lunsford being presented and received this 18th day of January 1797

This Indenture made the seventh day of April in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety six, and in the twentieth year of the Independance of the United States of America Between Isaac Wilkins of S^c Carolina Greenville County of the one part, and Edward Lunsford of State and County aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the s^d. Isaac Wilkins for and in consideration of the sum of three pounds Current money of S^c. Carolina to him the said Isaac Wilkins in hand well and Truly paid by the said Edwin Lunsford the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Isaac Wilkins hath granted bargained, sold aliened Released conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release convey and confirm unto the said Edwin Lunsford his heirs and assigns for ever a tract or parcel of land containing ten acres in adquare form fifty four poles in Length and thirty in Breadth from a white oak corner tree of his S 556 on Snoddy's line, which is to be the long side of the said ten acres of Land, Situated on a branch of North Saluda in the North corner of a tract of land containing four thousand acres granted to Robert Prince dated the seventh day of March one thousand seven hundred and eighty eight with all the houses outhouses trees woods under woods commons common of pastures, ways waters water courses and appurtenances whatsoever to the same belonging or any ways appurtenances, and all the estate right title Interest dowers claims and demands whatsoever of him the said Isaac Wilkins of in & to the said parcels of land and every part thereof to have and to hold the said bargained premises, and all and singular the said premises above mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Edwin Lunsford his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of him the s^d. Edwin Lunsford his heirs and assigns for ever, and he the said Isaac Wilkins for himself his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and for ever defend from any person or persons laying any lawful claim to the s^d. premises of Lunsford witness whereof he the s^d. Isaac Wilkins hath set his seal the day and year above written
