The following deed of Conveyance from John Tubb to Benjamin Benson being proven before John Blackwell Esq^r by the oath of Joseph Benson was presented and Recorded this 16th day of January 1797 This Indenture made this twenty ninth day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between John Tubb of the State of South Carolina and Greenville County of the one part and Benjamin Benson of the State and County aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said John Tubb for the consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Benson, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, and I the said John Tubb have granted bargained & sold unto the said Benjamin Benson part of two Tracts of land on the branches of Enoree near the head one of the tracts Originally granted to the said Tubb by his Excellency William Moultrie Esq^r the fifth day of June one thousand seven hundred & eighty six, the other granted to Zachariah Blackwell the first day of August one thousand seven hundred and eighty six by William Moultrie Esq^r Beginning at the north fork of one of the branches of Enoree at a post thence up the several meanders of the said Branch until it Intersects Blackwells line thence up the said Branch
