348 The following Deed of Conveyance from Richard Hooper to Joseph Reason-
 over being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq^r by the oath of Young Griffin
 was presented and recorded this 5th day of April 1797
 This Indenture made this eighteenth day of January one thousand seven
 hundred and ninety seven between Richard Hooper of South Carolina
 & Pendleton County of the one part, & Joseph Reasonover of the other part, of
 the aforesaid State and County of Greenville witnesseth that the said Richard
 Hooper for the consideration of the sum of forty pounds paid by the S^r
 Joseph Reasonover the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & the said
 Richard Hooper have granted bargained & sold unto the said Joseph Reason-
 over a certain tract or parcel of land containing three hundred acres of
 land more or less it being a part of three surveys two surveys of them
 granted Obadiah Hooper Sen^r one thousand seven hundred and eighty six the
 other granted to Obadiah Hooper Jun^r one thousand seven hundred & eighty
 seven beginning at a place running South course to a Conditional line between
 Lewis & Richard Hooper down S line to Mabias Spring branch thence
 down to Armsbrongs Creek to a place from thence to a Red oak corner
 from thence to a conditional line to Novices Spring branch being a condition:
 line between Hooper & Hooper & Sal. Young, up to a conditional line between
 S. Hooper & J. Reasonover from thence to a white oak corner from thence to a pine
 corner of W^m Hooper from thence to a stake from thence along the conditional
 line between S. Hooper & Hooper to a black Jack from thence to a stake
