372 The following Deed of Conveyance from James White to James Kelgore being proven before William Mitcheson Esq^r by the oath of John Kelgore was presented and Recorded this 20th day of April 1797 This Indenture made this twenty sixth day of May one thousand seven hundred and ninety six between James White of the State of South Carolina Orangeburg District of the one part, and James Kelgore of Greenville County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that for and in consideration of five hundred pounds lawful money in hand paid to the said James White by James Kelgore the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said James White hath bargained and sold unto the said James Kelgore, all that tract of land including six hundred and fifty acres the same being granted to James White by Patent bearing date the twenty sixth day of August 1774, and hath such Shape form Boundings and Boundings as will appear by a plat annexed to said grant the grant being for eight hundred acres & said White having heretofore conveyed a part of said 800 acre tract to Nathaniel Newmon, which includes the plantation where Henry Brockmon now lives supposed to be one hundred and fifty acres the balance included in said 800 acre survey bounding on the s^d side of Enoree river on Joseph Woolbanks, John Greer, Benjamin Kelgore Senior & Benjamin Kelgore Juniors lands and James Kelgore's land Originally granted to Moses White, also including the plantation where said James Kelgore now lives also the plantation where John Barger now lives as aforesaid situation both sides of Cribbs & Peters creeks is the land to be conveyed from said James White to James Kelgore be the same more or less, and that the said James White for himself his heirs Executors & Adm^rs doth warrant and agree to and with the said James Kelgore that he the said James Kelgore his heirs Executors Adm^rs or assigns or either of them may from time to time and at all times hereafter peaceably possess and enjoy all and every part of the above described land with all its appurtenances to him his heirs and assigns
