

The following Deed of Conveyance from Benjamin Reivil to Samuel Kelly  
being proven before James Kelgou Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Abner Ballar was  
presented and recorded this 11<sup>th</sup> day of June 1797

This Indenture made this 29<sup>th</sup> day of August one thousand seven hundred &  
ninety six between Benjamin Reivil of the State of South Carolina Green-  
ville County of the one part, and Samuel Kelly of the County of Saludaforesid  
of the other part witnesseth that the said Benjamin Reivil for and in con-  
sideration of seventeen pounds ten shillings lawful money to him in  
hand paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged the said Benja-  
min Reivil hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and  
sell alien Release and confirm unto Samuel Kelly all that tract or parcel of  
land containing one hundred and fifty acres of land it being a part of a  
Tract of 600 acres granted to said Benjamin Reivil the 17<sup>th</sup> day of May  
1787 the land to be conveyed begins as follows beginning at a red oak cor-  
ner old the N West corner of the the above mentioned tract of 600 acres of  
land & runs S 15 E on the Original line twenty one chains & fifty links to a  
red oak old marked for Joshua Owens on a line between said Reivil &  
Joshua Owen thence N 75 E on a marked line through said Tract agreeable  
to the course of the back line to include one hundred and fifty acres of  
land excepting as small quantity of land that now appears to be taken of the  
East corner of said Tract by a grant in the name of John Millyson  
bounding on the west side by land conveyed from John Peck to Samuel  
Kelly and the said Benjamin Reivil for himself his heirs Executors &  
Administr<sup>r</sup> doth covenant and agree to and with Samuel Kelly his heirs  
Exe<sup>r</sup> Administr<sup>r</sup> and assigns that he will for ever warrant and defend the above  
described land with all its appurtenances rents commodities hereditaments  
profits & losses thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining therunto  
except the above mentioned part that appears to be taken of by a grant in the  
name of John Millyson but that the said Samuel Kelly his heirs Exe<sup>r</sup> Administr<sup>r</sup>  
or assigns may at any time and at all times hereafter peaceably possess & enjoy  
all the balance of said one hundred and fifty acres of land with all its appur-  
tenances thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining thereto with-  
out any denial of him the said Benjamin Reivil his heirs Exe<sup>r</sup> Administr<sup>r</sup> or  
assigns or any other person laying any just or lawful right or claim thereto
