 conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do fully freely clearly and
 absolutely grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto the said Robert
 Skelton his heirs and assigns for ever a Tract of land containing one hun-
 dred acres more or less lying and being in the County of Greenville &
 State aforesaid being part of a Tract of land granted to William Russell
