The following deed of Conveyance from John McNeel to Daniel Stonecipher being proven before Reuben Barrett Esq. by the oath of Edward Hawkins was presented and Read this 9th day of September 1797

This Indenture made this sixteenth day of October one thousand seven hundred and ninety two and in the sixteenth year of America's independence between John McNeel of the State of South Carolina of the one part, and Daniel Stonecipher of the State of aforesaid and Washington District of the other part whereas by a certain grant bearing date the fifth day of April one thousand seven hundred and ninety from under the hand of Charles Pinckney Esq. Governor and commanded in and over s^d State for that purpose appointed did give grant unto s^d John McNeel a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and thirty three acres be the same more or less lying on Vaughns creek & running up both sides of a small fork of said creek and has such shape form and marks as appears by a plat to said grant annexed the said plat and grant being duly recorded in the Secretaries Office of s^d McNeel, witnesseth that said McNeel for the consideration of forty pounds to him in hand paid the rest whereof he has hereby ackn'd the said John McNeel hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Daniel Stonecipher his heirs and assigns that plantation or Tract of land containing one hundred and thirty three acres beginning at red oak, thence N 90 E 25 chan to a spanish oak, thence N 83 E 18 to white oak thence N 45 E 56 to a dogwood, thence S 27 W 47 to the beginning Together with all & singular the woods water profits commodities hereditaments & appurtenances whatsoever thereunto belonging or in any wise appurtenant to have and to hold the said Tract of Land hereby granted and sold with there and every of there appurtenances unto the s^d Stonecipher his heirs and assigns for ever and the s^d John McNeel for himself his heirs Executors Administrators & assigns the said bargained premises with appurtenances unto the s^d Daniel Stonecipher his heirs and assigns against the claim or claims of the s^d John McNeel his heirs administrators and assigns shall & will warrant & for ever defend by these presents in witness whereof the s^d John McNeel hath hereunto set his hand the day and date first above written
