 sented and Recorded this 19<sup>th</sup> day of September 1797  
 State of South Carolina, Know all men by these presents that Isaac Green &  
 Phebe Green of Greenville County and State aforesaid for and in consideration  
 of the sum of one hundred dollars paid by Robert M<sup>o</sup>ape of County & State aforesaid  
 said have granted bargained and sold and released and by these presents  
 do grant bargain sell and release unto the said Robert M<sup>o</sup>ape all that Tract  
 or parcel of land containing two hundred & twenty eight acres being a Tract of  
 land Originally granted to Isaac Green grant bearing date the thirteenth of  
 September one thousand seven hundred and ninety three and bounded as fol-  
 lows beginning at a Hickory and running S 17 W 80 chain 50 links to a red oak  
 thence E 25 chains to a pine, thence S 60 E 25 chains 50 links to a Hickory Stake, thence  
 N 80 E 15 chains to a pine, thence S 76 E 14 chains 50 links to a white oak, thence N.  
 80 E 16 chains to a post oak, thence N 26 chains to a red oak thence N 6 W 70 c.  
 and 50 links, thence to the beginning Together with all and singular the  
 rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises  
 belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold  
 all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said Robert M<sup>o</sup>  
 afe his heirs and assigns for ever, and do hereby bind our selves our heirs
