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The following deed of Conveyance from Thomas Bell to Lidy Ross being pro-  
 ceedings before Robert M. Cape Esquire be the oath of Reuben Cox was presented and  
 Recorded this 18<sup>th</sup> day of September 1897  
 This Indenture made this Twentieth day of August and in the year of our  
 Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety five and in the nineteenth year  
 of the Independence of the United States of America between Thomas Bell of  
 the State of South Carolina Greenville County of the one part and Lidy Ross  
 of the same State and County of the other part witnesseth that the said Thomas  
 Bell for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds Sterling money  
 to him in hand well and Truly paid by the said Lidy Ross at or before the  
 sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Thomas Bell  
 doth hereby acknowledge he the said Thomas Bell hath granted bargained sold  
 aliened and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien  
 and confirm unto the said Lidy Ross her heirs and assigns for ever and to  
 have and to hold unto the said Lidy Ross her heirs and assigns a certain  
 Tract of Land containing one hundred acres being half part of a tract of  
 two hundred acres granted to the said George Ross by his Excellency William Moultrie  
 Esq. Situate in the district of ninety six on both sides of Morgans  
 Creek of Enore river Joining the Tract of Land that the said Bell now lives  
 on bearing Date the 13<sup>th</sup> day of April one thousand seven hundred & Eighty  
 six Recorded in the Secretarys Office in grant book N. B. page 99 reference  
 being thereunto had may more fully appear Together with all Trees woods  
 under woods tithes commons common water and water courses whatsoever
