

The following deed of Conveyance from George Sanders to Richard Simmons being proven before Robert M. Asper Esq. by the oath of Elisha Smith was presented and Recorded this Eighth day of Jan^y 1798
 This Indenture made this Twenty day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four and of the Independence of the United States of America the nineteenth between George Sanders of Greenville County and State of South Carolina of the one part and Richard Simmons of the other part witnesseth that the said George Sanders for and in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling to him in hand paid by the said Richard Simmons the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said George Sanders hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell to the said Richard Simmons his heirs and assigns for ever a certain Tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres it being part of a Tract originally granted to George Russell lying and being in Greenville County on both sides of Kemps branch beginning on a red oak & running to Wm Russells line to a black oak thence along Russells line to a black oak from thence to a post oak, thence crossing Kemps branch at the mouth of a small branch to the beginning including the plantation whereon George Sanders now lives which is a Tract of land of one hundred acres be the same more or less with all and every of its appurtenances the said George Sanders doth from himself and his heirs and from any other person or persons whatsoever warrant and will for ever defend the said Richard Simmons his heirs and assigns for ever in witness whereof the said George Sanders hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and year first above written.

The following deed of Conveyance from George Salmon to Charlotte Sibley being proven before Thomas Edwards Esq. by the oath of Nancy Salmon was presented and Recorded this 10th day of January 1798
 State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I George Salmon of Greenville County and State aforesaid for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to me paid by Charlotte Sibley of the same place have granted bargained sold and released and by these presents do Grant bargain sell and release unto the said Charlotte Sibley a plantation or Tract of two hundred and forty six acres of land be the same more or less situate in Greenville County aforesaid on both sides of a small branch of Fall Creek of Checharoa River waters of Saluda River including part of the Chesnut Mountain Bounded Norwardly by John
