

The following deed of Conveyance from John Ross to James Ewins being proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq. by the oath of James Anderson was presented and Recorded this 16th January 1798

The State of South Carolina Greenville County Know all men by these presents that I John Ross of the State and County aforesaid in consideration of fifty pounds Sterling to me paid by Sa. Ewins of the State and County aforesaid have bargained sold and released & by these presents do grant bargain and release unto the said Sa. Ewins all that tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and ninety acres be the same more or less, beginning on a stake running thence N 59° 6' 31" 63 to a stake S +, thence N 40° W 9' to a stake S +, thence N 50° E 15' to a corner, thence N 30° W 27' to a stake S +, thence S 52° W 69' to a stake S +, thence S 40° E 22' - 36' to a stake S +, thence N 52° E 17' to a stake S +, thence S 40° E 15' - 14' to the beginning corner containing 190 acres be the same more or less lying and being on Horse Creek the waters of Reddy River part of a Tract of Land Orig^{ly} granted to the Meeks Together with all and singular the rights members hereditaments and appurtenances to the said premises belonging or in any wise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Ewins his heirs and assigns for ever, and I do hereby bind myself my heirs Executors & Administrators to warrant and for ever defend all and singular the said premises unto the said James Ewins his heirs and assigns against myself my heirs and assigns and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof for value Rec^d as witness my hand and Seal the twenty third day of Sept^r in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven and in the twenty second year of the Independance of the United States of America. The following deed of Conveyance from Henry Tate to Joseph M'afee being proven before Robert M'afee Esq. by the oath of William Thompson was presented and Recorded this 16th January 1798

This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety seven between Henry Tate of the State of North Carolina and County of Rutherford of the one part and Joseph M'afee of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the other part witnesseth that the said Henry Tate for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and thirty eight Dollars to him in hand paid by the said Joseph M'afee the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged he the said Henry Tate hath bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Joseph M'afee a certain
