

I Pleasant Sillivant of Greenville County and State aforesaid in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds sterling money to me paid by George Dabrymple of the aforesaid State and County have granted Bargained Sold and Released and by these presents do grant bargain sell and Release unto the said George Dabrymple all that part of a tract of Land he now lives on containing one hundred and thirty acres more or less Beginning on a St. 3x there Running N. 89. 00 on London known to a 38, 0, 3x there West 38 1/2 on Peter pinders Land to a 50 3x there South 89. 00 on McBeals Land to a St. 3x there E 38 40 there Throu the original Tract to the Beginning Corner containing one hundred and thirty acres of Land the same being a part of a tract of Land originally granted unto Nutelet Sillivant by the States Letter patent under the hand of William Moultrie the then Governor bearing date the first Day of May one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty six the S. Land Lying on the waters of Beady River Now the S. Pleasant Sillivant having granted & Released unto the George Dabrymple all that part of Land as above mentioned together with all and singular the premises the Rights members hereditaments and appertainments to the said premises belonging or in anywise Incident or appertaining to have and to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto the S. George Dabrymple his heirs and assigns for ever and I do here by binding myself my heirs Executors and administrators do warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the S. George Dabrymple his heirs and assigns against myself and my heirs and against every person whomsoever lawfully claiming or to claim the same or any part or parcel thereof it being for value Received of him as Witness my hand and Seal this twenty fifth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred and Ninety eight in the twenty seventh year of our said the Independancy of the united States of America.
