The following Deed of Conveyance from John Peden to Burrel Mafsey being proven before John Alexander Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of John Morton was presented and Recorded this 3<sup>d</sup> day of April 1798  
This Instrument made the 16<sup>th</sup> day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Seven hundred & ninety five in the seventh Sovereignty & independence of the United States of America the Nineteenth Between John Peden of the County of Greenville & State of South Carolina of the one part & Burrel Mafsey of the County & State aforesaid of the other part It is agreed that the said John Peden for & in consideration of the sum of thirty pounds Sterling money of this State to him in hand well and truly paid by the said Burrel Mafsey at and before the sealing & delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby fully acknowledged has granted, bargained, sold, aline, released, & confirmed & by these presents doth grant bargain, sell, alien, release & confirm unto the said Burrel Mafsey his heirs & assigns forever a certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred acres be the same more or less situate lying and being in Greenville County S<sup>t</sup> Carolina on the flat Back branch water of Ready River being a part of a tract of land containing one thousand seven hundred & fifty acre more or less granted to the said John Peden bearing date the 3<sup>d</sup> of November one thousand seven hundred & eighty six bounding East on John Alexander's N<sup>o</sup> East on James James Alexander's North on Stithians West on Jenkins land & on the South by part of the same survey, being divided by a line drawn from the head of a branch by the north corner of John Alexander's field to said Jenkins line, which tract or parcel of one hundred acres of land together with all & singular the Woods, trees waters hereditaments Biles Members & appurtenance what so ever to the said tract or parcel of land & premises hereby bargained & sold or in any wise appertaining, and Burrsing & Burrows remainder & remains his rents & yearly profits thereof to have & to hold the said tract or parcel of Land hereby bargain
