The following deed of conveyance from Samuel Walker to Luce Pector
 being proven before David Goodlett Esq. by the oath of Thomas Cowden
 was presented and recorded this 5th Day of April 1798
 This Indenture made this 27th of November in the year of our said
 one thousand seven hundred and ninety five and in the twenty ~~fourth~~ year of the
 Independence of the United States of America Between Sam^l Walker of
 Greenville County and State S^c Carolina of the one part & Luce Pector
 of the same County & State a free & of the other part Witnesseth for and
 in & in consideration of the sum of fifty five pounds to him in hand
 paid by Luce Pector both bargained and sold & by these presents
 do both bargain sell and make over unto Luce Pector a certain
 plantation or tract of Land containing one hundred and fifty acres
 more or less Lying in Greenville County on Rocky Branch a branch
 of Enoree River and that such boundaries whereat it being beginning on
 a post oak corner Running N 81st W 15 10 to a Red oak Corner
 thence N 19th W 24 to a stake corner thence S 86th W 8 to a stake
 Corner upon Sam^l Walker's line thence S 12th E 11 50 to a ash
 Corner thence S 19th E 3 50 to a spanish oak corner thence S 19th W
 to a conditional line made between Thomas Cowden & Luce Pector
 Beginning in the Swamp upon a conditional stake corner
 thence a straight line to an oak corner to the Back line from thence
 S 70th W to a Black oak station thence to a stake corner thence
 N 15th W 23 30 to the beginning corner it being a part of a
 of two tract of Land one tract granted unto Mr. Miller from under
 the hand of his excellency Mr. Moutree Esq. bearing date of
