This Indenture made this seventh Day of October in the year
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety four between Solomon
 Murphree of the County of pendleton & state of South Carolina
 of one part & William Thurston of the County of Greenville & state
 afores^d of the other part witnesseth that the said Solomon Murphree
 for & in consideration of the sum of fifty pounds Sterling money of
 South Carolina to him In hand paid before the sealing & Delivered
 of these presents by him the S^d William Thurston the receipt where
 of the S^d Solomon Murphree doth here by acknowledge & him
 self there with fully satisfied & of Every part & parts thereof
 doth hereby acquit & discharge the S^d William Thurston &
 his heirs forever hath granted Bargained sold & conveyed & by
