

3 Highlower being proven before Robert Cook Esq^r by the oaths of Martin Adams & Peter Cantrell was presented and Recorded this 10th day of May 1798
This Indenture made this first day of December on thousand and seven
hundred and ninety seven between Joseph Terry of the County of
Greenville and state of South Carolina of the first part and Epaphro-
ditus Highlower of the state and County aforesaid of the second part
witnesseth that the sd Epaphroditus Highlower for and in conse-
deration of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid at or before
the sealing and delivering of these presents and the receipt where-
of he has hereby acknowledged hath given granted bargained
and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell
allease and release convey and confirm unto the said Epaphroditus
Highlower his heirs and assigns forever a certain tract or par-
cel of land situated lying and being in said state and coun-
ty above written on both sides of the Beaver dam Creek part of
a survey originally granted to Joseph Vaughn hath such buttings
and bounds as follows (viz) beginning on the North side of said creek
on a red oak corner on the short branch thence S. W. strait line
to Ralph Smiths line thence along the line crossing the said
creek three times by the back of the Creek to a dead Maple corner thence
N. E. state line to a red oak corner which is said Joseph Terry corner
granted to Thomas Farrow thence strait line oppisit a certain
log fence which is a virel^t line between S. Terry and s. d. High-
lower thence along the said log fence strait line to the beginning
corner containing one hundred acres more or less together with
all woods ways waters water courses improvements and appur-
tainances what soever unto the same belonging or in any wise
appertaining in fee simple rents and issues unto the said
Epaphroditus Highlower his heirs and assigns forever free and
clear from all fine m. benes what soever peaceably and quiet-
ly to possess & enjoy the tract of land above described and
Every part and parcel thereof unto the only use and behoof of him
the said Epaphroditus Highlower his heirs and assigns forever
the sd Joseph Terry binds himself his heirs and assigns unto the
sd Epaphroditus Highlower his heirs and assigns for the above
tract of land and appurtenances there unto belonging against
all and every person or persons what soever law fully claim-
ing the same shall and will warrant as well in equity as in

This Indenture following D^r of conveyance from Martin Adams to Epaphroditus Highlower being proven before Robert Cook Esq^r by the oath
of Peter Cantrell was presented and Recorded this 10th day of May 1798
This Indenture made this third day of February in the year four hundred one
thousand seven hundred and ninety eight between Martin Adams
and Alsey his wife of the County of Greenville and state of South Carolina
of the first part and Epaphroditus Highlower of the state and
county aforesaid of the second part witnesseth that the said Martin
Adams and Alsey his wife for and in consideration of the sum of
two hundred Dollars to the said Martin Adams & Alsey his wife
in hand paid by the said Epaphroditus Highlower at and before
the sealing and delivering of these presents the right whereof is hereby
acknowledged and thereof and from every part and parcel thereof
doth hereby acquit the said Epaphroditus Highlower by these
presents hath granted bargained sold allease and confirmed
and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and
confirm unto the said Epaphroditus Highlower in his actua-
l profession and to his heirs and assigns forever all that
tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the said County
of Greenville in the district of Ninety six of the branches of the
Beaver dam Creek and was granted the same to Martin Adam
by Charles Pinckney Esq^r of the said state of South Carolina with
the great seal of the state there to annexed and bounded as
followeth beginning at a stake running N. twenty
three E. fifty chains to a red oak thence N. sixty seven E. twenty
chains to a M^t & thence S. twenty three W. fifty chains to
stake thence S. sixty seven E. twenty chains to the beginning
stake containing one hundred acres with in the said course
and boundaries together with woods trees commodities advan-
tages emoluments prey ledges and advantages whatsoever to
the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining issues
and profits of the land and premises with all the estate right
title interest property claimed and demand what soever both
in law and Equity of the said Martin Adams and Alsey his wife
