Kelly and on the S. by Isaac Towns Land and hath such Shapes & Markes; as Doth appear from a Plat annexed to a Grant in the name of Joshua Sanders for the aforesaid 250 Acres Bearing Date the first Day of January in the year of our Lord (1789) and Recorded in Grant Book (6666) page (354) together with all and singular the rights Members Hereditaments and Appertinances to the said Premises belonging or in any wise Appertaining or Incident to have & to Hold all & singular the premises before mentioned unto the said James Lewis his Heirs and Assigns forever and I do Heely bind myself my Heirs Executors &

26 The following Deed of Conveyance from Frederick Farmer & Sally Farmer to Samuel Roberts being proven before Humphrey Cobb Esq. by the oath of Hugh Cumbly was presented and Recorded this 25<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1798 This Indenture made this the twenty fourth Day of October on the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight in the twenty first year of American Independence between Frederick Farmer & Sally his wife of the County of Greenville & State of S. Carolina of the one part & Samuel Roberts of the other County & State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that the said Frederick Farmer & Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to them in hand paid at or before the sealing & Delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they acknowledge the said Frederick Farmer & Sally his wife hath given granted & sold & confirmed & by these presents doth give grant bargain sell & confirm unto the said Saml Roberts his Heirs a certain Tract or parcel of Land situated lying & being in ninety six District containing one hundred acres more or less it being part of one hundred & seventy acres surveyed for & granted to John Waldrop by this Excellency William Moutree the fourth Day of February one thousand seven hundred & ninety three Laying on Rocky Creek a branch of the Golden Grove beginning at the Mouth of a branch that runs through the field where David Jones now lives thence along the line first run round the said land to the corner stake thence to a post oak corner thence to a post oak corner thence along the line to a conditional line of William Thompsons on thence along the line to a conditional line to the ridge road to David Jones conditional line to the end of the branch all the beginning together with all & singular the rights &
