North side of Broad River Running from thence south to a post
on the long branch from thence up the R^d branch to a black oak
thence east to a pine fence North to a post oak thence south to
a white oak thence west to a dogwood up sd River thence down the
R^d River to the beginning joins bare hills along the public land
together with all & singular the Rights to members hereditaments
& appurtenances to the sd premises belonging or in any wise Incident
or appertaining to have & to hold all & singular the premises before
mentioned unto the R^d Israel Rains his heirs & assigns forever
hereby giving our heirs & executors & administrators to warrant and forever
defend all & singular the sd premises unto the R^d Israel Rains his heirs
& assigns against our heirs & assigns or any other person lawfully claiming
to claim the same or any part thereof witness our hands this
13 day of November 1797 and in the twenty first year of the Indepen-
dence of the United States of America
