18 The following Deed of Conveyance from Hugh Nelson to Isaac Stevens being pronounced by Robert Barnett Esq^r by the oath of Robert Nelson was presented and Recorded this 29th Day of June 1798
This indenture made this 14 Day of may 1796 & in the twenty fifth year of american Independence between Hugh Nelson of the State of South Carolina & Pendleton County of the one part and Isaac Stevens of the County of Greenville and state aforesaid of the other part where as in and by a certain grant bargained date the second day of may 1796 under the hand of his Exe Cntry Charles Pinckney Esq^r Governor and Commander in chief in and over the sd state have the great seal of S^t State there unto affixed did give & grant unto Hugh Nelson a tract of Land containing 127 acres situated in Greenville County on a branch of south Tigris River bounded by a line running N.E. by land surveyed for Major Parsons to the W by land granted to Uriah Comer & C. by Robert Nelsons late the other sides vacant & hath such form and mark as appears by a plat to the said grant annexed said grant being duly Recorded in

Hugh Nelson for and in consideration of the sum of £30 sterl^g money to him in hand paid by the S. Isaac Stevens before the sealing & delivering of these presents the Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted Bargained sold alined Conveyed and by the these presents doth grant bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the S. Isaac Stevens the above Described tract of one hundred and twenty acres of land to gather with all and singular the Woods under woods ways waters water courses houses buildings guardings orchards hereditaments & appertinances unto the sd land being or in any wise appertaining and the Reversion & Reversions Remainder & Remainders Rents dues and profits there unto belonging to have and to hold the R. Granted premises of one hundred and twenty seven acres of land unto the S. Isaac Stevens his heirs executors adm^t and assigns for ever and that the R. Hugh Nelson his heirs executors adm^t and assigns doth covenant and agree to and with the S. Isaac Stevens his heirs by adm^t and assigns that they shall at all times here after peaceably and quietly occupy possess and enjoy the sd tract of one hundred and twenty seven acres of land above mentioned from all and every other former bargainer mortgages judgments or Dowers & all other incumbrances whatsoever and that the R. Hugh Nelson his heirs successors will warrant & forever defend the sd tract of one hundred & twenty seven acres of land unto the S. Isaac Stevens his heirs and exec^t adm^t and assigns from all and every other person or persons that shall any title or claim justly there unto in Wit ness Whereof he the R. Hugh Nelson hath here unto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and first above written in presence of us

State of South Carolina Know all men by these presents that I Michael Purkiss of the State of South Carolina formerly of Greenville County State of South Carolina in consideration of Two hundred & fifty Dollars to me paid by William Peeler of Greenville County & State of South Carolina Farmer have granted bargained sold, and released and by these presents do grant bargain sell & release unto the said William Peeler a certain tract of land lying & being in Greenville County and on Judy Street being for
