That Indenture Made the thirty first day of July in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety three and in the
Seventeenth year of the independency of America between
William Davis of the State of South Carolina Ninety six
District and Greenville County of the one part and John Davis
of the State & District aforesaid and Greenville County of the
other part where as in aid by a certain Grant bearing
date the thirty first day of July one thousand Seven hundred
and Ninety three from under the hand of his Excellency William
Monttrie Esq^r Governor for the time being did give and grant
unto William Davis a certain tract of land containing two
hundred acres situate in Greenville County Bounding as follows
on the North East on the South East by vacant land on the South
west by vacant land on the north West vacant land and
hath such marks as appear by a Plat to said Grant annexed it being
Auly Recorded in the Secretorys office Witnesseth that the said
William Davis for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty pounds
