



Branch running along the old line to a Spanish Oak Corner thence  
 the dementions of the old line to a Hickory Stake Corner Dills  
 Survey thence along the old line to the creek thence up the creek  
 to the fork thence up the fork leaving from the beginning white  
 oak station the branch to be the line supposed to be fifty acres  
 more or less other eight acres tract beginning on a hickory on  
 the creek of the land survey to William Dill running down  
 with the dementions of the creek to a hickory corner a quon  
 by James Capland and said Holcomb thence a direct course  
 to a Hickory on the top of the hill on the old line about one  
 hundred and fifty from the corner on a Spanish Oak near to  
 where William Callaway now lives & originally made by Dill  
 on his first survey thence the demention of the old line to the  
 beginning hickory on the creek supposed to be eight acres  
 more or less Together with all and singular the right  
 members Hereditaments and appurtenances to the same  
 premises belonging or in any wise appertaining to have and  
 to hold all and singular the premises before mentioned unto  
 the said Jesse Davis his heirs and assigns forever and sold  
 here by Bond myself my heirs Executors administrators  
 & assigns to warrant and forever defend all and singular  
 the premises aforesaid unto the said Jesse Davis his  
 heirs and assigns and ag<sup>t</sup> all and every other person or persons  
 claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof In witness  
 whereof the said Archer Holcomb have hereunto set my  
 hand and affixed my seal this twenty eighth day of September  
 in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & Ninety eight  
 and in the Twenty third year of American Independence

The following deed of Conveyance from Daniel Helly to Samuel  
 Carl being prove before William Goodlett Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Matthew  
 Helly was presented and Recorded this 14<sup>th</sup> day of Jan<sup>y</sup> 1799  
 This Indenture made this the Twenty first day of June in the  
 year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Ninety five in the  
 fourteenth year of the Independence of the United States of  
 America between Daniel Helly of Greenville County State of

South Carolina of the one part & Samuel Carl Jun<sup>r</sup> of the State of Caro-  
 lina of the other part Witnesseth that he the said Daniel  
 Helly for & in consideration of the sum of Nineteen Pounds Ster-  
 ling to him in hand paid the Receipt to here by Acknow-  
 ledge have granted Bargained sold & conveyed & by these presents  
 do confirm unto the said Samuel Carl Jun<sup>r</sup> and his heirs for-  
 ever all that tract or plantation of Land containing one hundred  
 Acres Granted by his Excellency Charles Pinckney April one thou-  
 sand seven hundred and Eighty Nine being and bounding as  
 follows on the South and West by Fosters Branch Joining  
 John Jones John Fosters & William Goodletts & Joseph Wrights  
 Land being part of a Grant of the above state Together with all  
 profits & Benefits to the only use & behoof of him the said  
 Samuel Carl his heirs & assigns forever he the said Samuel  
 Carl Jun<sup>r</sup> shall at all times here after peaceably hold possess  
 & enjoy the aforesaid Land and premises a above mentioned with  
 out any hindrance or Interruption of him the said Daniel  
 Helly from or by him or his heirs or any other person what soever  
 & Lastly the said Daniel Helly shall hereby warrant & forever  
 defend the same In witness whereof he hath hereunto set  
 his hand and affixed his seal the day & year first written  
 Signed Sealed & acknowledged before me of  
 Charles Dougherty } the words South & West  
 Jun<sup>r</sup> of Samuel Carl Jun<sup>r</sup> the full Consideration Money before  
 Mentioned & pay Received by Me the day before Written  
 Charles Dougherty } I. Helly 

The following deed of Conveyance from Matthew Caldwell to William  
 Hodges being prove before Robert Cook Esq<sup>r</sup> by the oath of Ephraim  
 Flight over was presented and Recorded this 13<sup>th</sup> day of January 1799  
 This Indenture made the twenty Ninth day of September in the year  
 of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Ninety five between William  
 Hodges of the State of South Carolina and County of Greenville of the one  
 part & Matthew Caldwell well of the State and County aforesaid of the other  
 part witnesseth that the said Matthew Caldwell for the Considera-  
 tion of the sum of one hundred pounds Sterling to him in hand paid  
 by the said William Hodges and him the said Matthew Caldwell  
 fully satisfied there with and acknowledge the right to be Just  
 he hath given granted sold & by these presents do give grant bargain  
 sell & convey unto the said W<sup>m</sup> Hodges his heirs and assigns forever  
 certain piece or tract of Land situate & lying in the State and
